Humanitarian Protection Discretionary Leave Indefinite Leave to Remain Exceptional Leave to Remain	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 16 – 18 years old: can apply for support</li> <li>- over 19 years old: can apply after being resident in the UK for 3 years</li> </ul>
Refugee Status	Can apply for any type of student support
Migrant	Can apply if: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- coming from the European Union</li> <li>- resident in the UK</li> </ul>
